Declaration of Pregnancy

In accordance with New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection regulations in N.J.A.C 7:28-6.1 (which references NRC regulations 10 CFR20.1003 and 20.1208), a pregnant woman who wishes to control radiation dose to the fetus/embryo resulting from occupational exposure, must voluntarily and, in writing, declare her pregnancy to her employer, so that the employer may apply the fetal dose limits set forth in 20.1208.

The New Jersey Department of Environmental Protection requires that the estimated date of conception be provided to allow the employer to calculate the cumulative fetal dose.

In accordance with N.J.A.C 7:28-6.1, and 10CFR20.1003 and 20.1208, I am declaring my pregnancy. The estimated date of conception is _____.
